a collaborative Vanipedia project


This initiative developed from the desire to share Srila Prabhupada's teachings with all devotees by publishing Vaniquotes in temples, restaurants, devotees homes, BBT offices and all other places, where one can stop for a moment, and read Srila Prabhupada's enlightening and encouraging words. With the purpose of having Srila Prabhupada's words nicely presented the idea came to have a dedicated Srila Prabhupada Wall consisting of his quotes that could be changed regularly in order for the devotees and visitors to read them continuously.

The statements on these Walls are drawn from Srila Prabhupada's 85+ books, 1950+ lectures, 905+ conversations, 490+ morning walks, 65+ interviews and 6,570+ of his letters. Information available at Vanipedia.org.

Now we are inspired to encourage more Srila Prabhupada Walls to be created in ISKCON properties and devotees homes around the world. What a wonderful offering to our Founder-Acarya and all his followers by establishing at least 32 big walls, 64 medium walls and 108 small walls during ISKCON's 50th year celebrations.

On the 17th of January 2016, in the presence of the BBT devotees of South America the first Srila Prabhupada Wall was inaugurated at Iskcon's Mexico City temple.

With great anticipation we started preparing our wall. We are not experts at all in these







areas so it was only by the grace of Lord Krshna that we could do this

We started sketching out ideas - Have a big photo of Srila Prabhupada at the top, a beautiful title, frames that can show nicely the instructions of our Founder-Acarya. At the bottom have information about Vanipedia and an invitation to participate in the seva of translating Srila Prabhupada's words in our language.



We wanted to cover the widest possible space. The final size is 2.50 meters high and 2.30 meters wide.

The Work Plan

- STEP 1. Design the wall to the size we required.
- STEP 2. Building the wall.
- STEP 3. Repairing and painting the room.
- STEP 4. Decoration.
- STEP 5. Vaniquotes design.
- STEP 6. The Title.
- STEP 7. Srila Prabhupada photo.
- STEP 8. Diplomas to donors.
- STEP 9. Inauguration party and music.
- STEP 10. Video and photos.
- STEP 11. Reporting and Publishing.








Design the wall to the size we required.


After the sankirtan marathon, Bhakta Alejandro joined us to make a wonderful final varnishing using some professional tools.
















Ananta Deva prabhu (left) and the Instalator (right)

Vaniquotes design


We wanted to show devotees and visitors Srila Prabhupada's words with an excellent presentation.



The work for the vaniquotes design was really mystical, as we tried to find the correct colors, fonts, size, logos and of course the translation into Spanish of the vaniquotes.

All this labor was made by Hari Mohan prabhu, really late at night. Visnu Murti prabhu was also helping us to choose the fonts, giving us ideas and explaining how we can share the vaniquotes. We discussed by Skype all these details.

The translations were made by Rasa Gamya devi dasi, she is a vaniservant since last year. She was not in the City but by means of the internet we had her wonderful association. We decided to have 12 vaniquotes in Spanish and 4 vaniquotes in English for foreign visitors and to help us learn better English.

We wanted this photo but the pixels were not what we needed, so we choose another that was perfect for the design and colors, It was just two days before the inauguration.










Diplomas to donors
